### **Ecumenical Lenten Luncheons**

March 25<sup>th</sup> is our week for hospitality Fr. Ward will be preaching.

<u>The Easter Triduum</u> Thursday, April 9th - Sunday April 12th. Dear Friends in Christ.

In the readings this weekend we hear of the Original Sin, the fall of Adam and Eve after the enticement of

the devil: Man, tempted by the devil, let his trust in his Creator die in his heart and, abusing his freedom, disobeyed God's command. This is what man's first sin consisted of. All subsequent sin would be disobedience toward God and lack of trust in his goodness. (CCC, #397)

Lent is then an opportunity to renew our trust in God as we continue to contend with allure of sin and the temptations that come from the world, the flesh and the devil. In fact, our decision to embrace suffering during Lent is the means by which we grow in our love for God and encounter, in a deeper way, His love for us. St. Faustina in her Diary of Divine Mercy helps us understand the fruits of uniting our suffering to God's love:

"Great love can change small things into great ones, and it is only love which lends value to our actions. And the purer our love becomes, the less there will be within us for the flames of suffering to feed upon, and the suffering will cease to be a suffering for us; it will become a delight! By the grace of God, I have received such a disposition of heart that I am never so happy as when I suffer for Jesus, whom I love with every beat of my heart." (303, page 140)

It may be the case that we struggle to keep our Lenten resolutions. St. Faustina teaches us how to deal with our weaknesses:

"When I see that the burden is beyond my strength, I do not consider or analyze it or probe into it, but I run like a child to the Heart of Jesus and say only one word to Him: "You can do all things." And then I keep silent, because I know that Jesus Himself will intervene in the matter, and as for me, instead of tormenting myself, I use that time to love Him." (1033, page 392)

It is my prayer for you all that this Lent be a time of spiritual growth and deeper trust in God. Grace be with you,
