Dear friends in Christ,

In the First Reading this weekend we hear the prophetic word that finds its fulfillment in Christ:...**he shall proclaim peace to the nations. His dominion shall be from sea to sea, and from the River to the ends of the earth.**

The Gospel is meant for all people of all times and places. Jesus exhorted His apostles **Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.** (Matthew 28:19-20) We find an invitation in the Gospel this weekend where Jesus reveals His desire to meet each and everyone of us in our struggles and learn to trust in Him:

Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light.

In order to have an opportunity to draw near to Christ, Jesus gave us the liturgy and the sacraments as the primary means by which we come to be yoked with Him. The Second Vatican Council explains:

The liturgy in its turn moves the faithful, filled with "the paschal sacraments," to be "one in holiness"; it prays that "they may hold fast in their lives to what they have grasped by their faith"; the renewal in the Eucharist of the covenant between the Lord and man draws the faithful into the compelling love of Christ and sets them on fire. From the liturgy, therefore, and especially from the Eucharist, as from a font, grace is poured forth upon us; and the sanctification of men in Christ and the glorification of God, to which all other activities of the Church are directed as toward their end, is achieved in the most efficacious possible way. (SACROSANCTUM CONCILIUM, #10)

In other words, our blessed Lord desires that all people hear the invitation not only to be baptised, but also to be nourished and renewed by the ultimate sacrament of His love: **I will not reject anyone who comes to me... I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.** (John 6:37,51)
