#### Dear Friends in Christ.

The Gospel this weekend seems to relate our Lord speaking words that, at first glance, seem harsh: But the woman came and did Jesus homage, saying, "Lord, help me." He said in reply, "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs."

he children the Lord is referencing is the chosen people; the people of Israel. It is important for us to understand that the Lord guided the Israelites from their slavery in Egypt to the Promised Land so as to foreshadow the many gift and graces that would ultimately be revealed to us in Christ.

Furthermore, the woman recognizes the children of Israel as being the children of God when she exclaims "Please, Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters." Once this recognition is made by the woman, her request for healing for her daughter is granted: Then Jesus said to her in reply, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish."

The Second Vatican Council, in its document on how to interpret Divine Revelation, *Dei Verbum* (The Word of God) explains the relationship between the Old and the New Testaments:

The plan of salvation foretold by the sacred authors, recounted and explained by them, is found as the true word of God in the books of the Old Testament: these books, therefore, written under divine inspiration, remain permanently valuable. "For all that was written for our instruction, so that by steadfastness and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope" (Rom. 15:4). ... God, the inspirer and author of both Testaments, wisely arranged that the New Testament be hidden in the Old and the Old be made manifest in the New. For, though Christ established the new covenant in His blood (see Luke 22:20; 1 Cor. 11:25), still the books of the Old Testament with all their parts, caught up into the proclamation of the Gospel, acquire and show forth their full meaning in the New Testament (see Matt. 5:17; Luke 24:27; Rom. 16:25-26; 2 Cor. 14:16) and in turn shed light on it and explain it. (Dei Verbum, #14.16)

We should rejoice that we are now the new Chosen People and the children of God who, through Christ can confidently call out to our Heavenly Father in the midst of every trial. Let us pray to the Lord with great trust that He will hear and answer our prayers. Grace be with you,


