Dear friends in Christ,

In the Second Reading this weekend St. Paul invites us to know more and more the truths that have been revealed to us in Christ: Do not conform yourselves to this age but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and pleasing and perfect. Pope John Paul II, in his encyclical The Splendor of the Truth (Veritatis Splendor) explains this further:

The light of God's face shines in all its beauty on the countenance of Jesus Christ, "the image of the invisible God" (Col 1:15), the "reflection of God's glory" (Heb 1:3), "full of grace and truth" (Jn 1:14). Christ is "the way, and the truth, and the life" (Jn 14:6). Consequently the decisive answer to every one of man's questions, his religious and moral questions in particular, is given by Jesus Christ, or rather is Jesus Christ Himself, ...It is Christ... who fully discloses man to himself and unfolds his noble calling by revealing the mystery of the Father and the Father's love". (Veritatis Splendor, #88)

In other words, in Jesus are found the truths that, when lived are an exercise of authentic freedom. It is Jesus who invites us to a truly generous and even sacrificial love. In fact, it is our encounter with the Lord every Sabbath that gives us the grace to both know and follow Him, fulfilling the demands of love. Again, Pope John Paul II makes this clear when, in the same encyclical he teaches the following:

...flowing from and nourished by that inexhaustible source of holiness and glorification of God which is found in the Sacraments, especially in the Eucharist: by sharing in the sacrifice of the Cross, the Christian partakes of Christ's self-giving love and is equipped and committed to live this same charity in all his thoughts and deeds. (Veritatis Splendor, #108)

The renewal in the life of grace gained when we open ourselves to the power of the sacraments is what makes each of us the person we most want to be. This is an ongoing reality and a journey of self discovery that conforms us to the very life of Christ and the freedom of His love and truth. Grace be with you,


