Dear friends in Christ,

"He said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard." These are words of Our Lord that could be said to any priest and to me as I arrive here at Christ Our Hope Parish. It is a blessing to be here with all of you at Christ Our Hope as your priest. I hope to get to know as many of you as I can however long I am here. You might be wondering why I was assigned here as temporary administrator. I was ordained a priest a little over three years ago, and in these three years it has become clear to me that the Lord is calling me to a more contemplative life in a monastery.

I have been in conversation with our Bishop, who has given me permission to leave to join the monastery. The particular monastery I am going to is in Ireland, and between the immigration process and COVID-19 my leaving has been delayed by several months. I know this might seem like an unstable situation for Christ Our Hope Parish. It might seem as though I am only passing through. However, this does not mean I will not be as present to you all as I can. When we think about it, however, each one of us really is "passing through" in a spiritual sense. Saint Paul reminds us of what is essential: "If I go on living in the flesh, that means fruitful labor for me. And I do not know which I shall choose. I am caught between the two.

I long to depart this life and be with Christ, for that is far better." St. Thomas Aquinas and other great saints often referred to those still living in this world as "wayfarers" on our way to eternity, our true homeland with the Lord. Like St. Paul, each one of us ought to live with one foot on earth and another foot in heaven. Each day we wake up we are one day closer to that reality. Each day another opportunity to love the Lord Jesus and draw closer to His Sacred Heart. This parish is called "Christ Our Hope" and the virtue of hope is a "firm trust that God will give us eternal life and the means to obtain it." He knows our struggles, He knows our weaknesses, but He knows we are His adopted children and so does our Blessed Mother. St. 'Padre' Pio famously said "Pray, hope and don't worry." Please keep me in your prayers and I hope to draw closer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus with you all, through Mary's Immaculate Heart.
