Dear Friends in Christ,

October 7th is the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. It was instituted after October 7th, 1571. On that day the navy of the Ottoman Turks raced towards Italy and Western Europe to conquer it. As they sailed past Lepanto in Greece they met a combined naval fleet of Spain, Venice and the Papal States called the "Holy League". The odds were greatly stacked against the Christian fleet. Pope St. Pius V sent out a notice to all of Catholic Europe telling them to pray the Rosary. The Christian sailors in the Holy League ships prayed the Rosary as well. By the end of the battle the Christian fleet had won a major victory, losing only a few ships. The navy of the Ottoman Turkish empire was almost completely wiped out. Rome, and Christian Europe had been saved.

Spiritually, the Rosary is our weapon against evil. Countless saints have prayed the

Rosary and told others to do so. Most importantly, Our Lady told the children at Fatima to pray the Rosary daily. One of the children at Fatima, Lucia (now Venerable Lucia) said years later, as a Carmelite nun, that a new efficacy has been given to the Rosary in these times. We are living in a post-Fatima world. The apparition of Our Lady at Fatima was a major message to us all. On October 13, 1917, in the final apparition of Our Lady, hundreds of people, including atheists, saw the sun dance through the sky and appear to fall to the earth. Some saw this from miles away. This miracle was on the scale of Biblical proportions. When had a miracle of this size happened since Noah's flood? When had so many hundreds seen the sun plummet towards the earth? Our Lady's message reiterates the importance of daily praying the Rosary, of repentance from sin in a world increasing distant from God.

During that apparition, St. Joseph appeared in the sky to the three children with the Child Jesus in his arms, they both blessed the world. This is the forgotten part of this apparition, but important. Venerable Sister Lucia said as well that the final battle between God and satan would be over the family. It is important that we call upon those in the Holy Family: Jesus, Mary and St. Joseph.

A few hundred years before Fatima, St. Louis De Monfort wrote the following in his book *The Secret of the Rosary*: "If you say the Rosary faithfully until death, I do assure you that, in spite of the gravity of your sins 'you shall receive a neverfading crown of glory.' Even if you are on the brink of damnation, even if you have one foot in hell, even if you have sold your soul to the devil as sorcerers do who practice black magic, and even if you are a heretic as obstinate as a devil, sooner or later you will be converted and will amend your life and save your soul, if - and mark well what I say - if you say the Rosary devoutly every day until death for the purpose of knowing the truth and obtaining contrition and pardon for your sins."


