Dear Friends in Christ,

In our Gospel this Sunday the Lord Jesus tells us: "Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God."

What does it mean to give monetary contributions to the church?

Saint Thomas Aquinas gives us a good summary: "...tithes are given to the clergy, not only for their own support, but also that the clergy may use them in assisting the poor. Hence they are not unnecessary;"

When we pay taxes, we pay the state, with the purpose (we hope) of the public good. This does not directly effect our relationship to God, but indirectly: such as public peace so that we

can practice our faith without persecution. Giving to the Church is of a higher order. The material "things" of the Church are used for the love of God and love of neighbor for the sake of God. In using the money given to assist the poor, the Church is acting in charity towards our neighbor for the sake of God. That money is also used for the church building, in which occurs the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. The altar bread and wine purchased is used at Mass and becomes the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ.

That money is used to do other things that pertain directly to God and to our spiritual life; acts of charity.

During this time we are working to raise money for the annual HOPE Appeal, the Diocese of Syracuse's annual giving campaign. This money is used by the Diocese in various ways in carrying out its mission of charitable works, as well as the other material necessities the Church needs to serve the Lord. Everything from assistance of the poor to support of seminarians in formation to the priesthood to vocation promotion to family ministry and catechesis and many other things.

I realize that giving during this time has become more difficult given the situation our society is in right now with the pandemic (among many other disturbances in the world). However, if we can still give what we can, it will go along way in acts of charity towards God and neighbor.

Our HOPE Appeal goal this year at Christ Our Hope is \$19,295.13. If every family gives \$175 (which equals about \$14.38 per month over one year) we will meet our goal. Please give what you can, even if it is only a small amount. Anything given out of love for God is worth giving. Whatever we give, let us do so with that intention of love Our Lord.




