Dear Friends in Christ,

What is fear? Fear is a reaction we have about an evil that has not happened yet, a future evil that we could suffer from. St. Thomas Aquinas says there are different types of fear - we could be afraid of 1) a large amount of work we do not want to get stuck with 2) fear of what others think of us, 3) fear that paralyzes us because of how big the threat is to us, 4) fear of something we are not used to dealing with or something unusual we do not regularly face and 5) a fear of an unknown harm, such as when a person is afraid of a spider, thinking they may or may not get bit.

A person knows a certain harm is going to occur they might move from being afraid to depression or despair, sorrow or anger. If we have some hope of overcoming whatever might cause is harm, the fear is not overpowering and we can take counsel and figure out a solution, but if there seems to be no hope of overcoming it we can face a certain despair.

There are many things to can cause fear within us. Our thoughts can be a filled with images that can cause fear. We absorb information from various forms of media that can cause fear. The more we think about those things, the more we get into a habit of thinking in that way. In order to get out of this we must choose to think differently, to fill our imagination with things other than the cause of the fear. This is one reason St. Paul said: "Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is gracious, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things." (Philippians 4:8) This is why so many saints spent so much time meditating—meditating on the Passion of Christ, His sufferings, His carrying His cross, the scene on Calvary, meditating on the virtues that Jesus had during His sufferings or the love He has for us, meditating on the Blessed Mother and her sorrows or the mysteries of the Rosary or on any part of scripture. Some saints spent a lot of time reading scripture — filling their minds with God's word.


