Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday we celebrate the feast of Christ the King, the final Sunday before the First Sunday of Advent. We are reminded in today's gospel of the final judgment and the end of the world. Traditionally, Catholics remembered the "Four Last Things" — Death, Judgment, Heaven and Hell. Today, what is so often forgotten about is eternity, the life after this life. We forget that this life is like a drop of water compared to the vast ocean of eternity. Yet, this is what we are constantly looking forward to. We want to be saints in heaven, in fact, from our baptism we are called to be saints in heaven. This is the very reason Jesus Christ was born, suffered, died and rose again and why He sent the Holy Spirit and left us His Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Blessed Sacrament—so that we could get to heaven.

We cannot dwell on where our loved ones are after death, only God knows and we do not have such knowledge or ability to judge another person, this is left to God alone. We can easily fall into despair doing this. We must simply pray for them and trust in God's mercy.

Here is what the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* tells us: "1021 Death puts an end to human life as the time open to either accepting or rejecting the divine grace manifested in Christ.592 The New Testament speaks of judgment primarily in its aspect of the final encounter with Christ in his second coming, but also repeatedly affirms that each will be rewarded immediately after death in accordance with his works and faith...

1022 Each man receives his eternal retribution in his immortal soul at the very moment of his death, in a particular judgment that refers his life to Christ: either entrance into the blessedness of heaven-through a purification or immediately, -- or immediate and everlasting damnation. 'At the evening of life, we shall be judged on our love.' [St. John of the Cross]

1038 The resurrection of all the dead, "of both the just and the unjust,"623 will precede the Last Judgment. This will be "the hour when all who are in the tombs will hear [the Son of man's] voice and come forth, those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of judgment." Then Christ will come "in his glory, and all the angels with him. . . . Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate them one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and he will place the sheep at his right hand, but the goats at the left. . . . And they will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life." [Matt. 25:31,32,46.]

1039 In the presence of Christ, who is Truth itself, the truth of each man's relationship with God will be laid bare. The Last Judgment will reveal even to its furthest consequences the good each person has done or failed to do during his earthly life:


1040 The Last Judgment will come when Christ returns in glory. Only the Father knows the day and the hour; only he determines the moment of its coming.

1041 The message of the Last Judgment calls men to conversion while God is still giving them "the acceptable time, . . . the day of salvation." It inspires a holy fear of God and commits them to the justice of the Kingdom of God. It proclaims the "blessed hope" of the Lord's return, when he will come "to be glorified in his saints, and to be marveled at in all who have believed."
