Dear Friends in Christ. This Sunday, the First Sunday of Advent we enter into our spiritual preparation for Christmas. Years ago, on the vigil of a great feast, the color violet would be used at Mass. This color symbolizes a penitential day or season. It is meant to prepare us to receive the graces God wishes to give us for that particular feast through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Through these three things we strive to empty out spiritually whatever in us is keeping God from working in our soul. Prayer, fasting and almsgiving and penitential practices in general help to train our will so that we strive to do God's will alone. Advent and Lent are both several weeks long, which shows us the importance of Christmas and Easter and how much the Lord wants us to prepare spiritually.

There is an old traditional prayer that would be said during Advent that can be a help in meditating on Jesus' birth. This would be said 15 times each day starting on the feast of St. Andrew (November 30) until Christmas. Saying this prayer and meditating on it can help us keep our mind set in Advent looking ahead to Christmas. It tells us to be attentive to the time in which God Himself came into our world. God the one who created all things, enters into the world HE created, in order to save humanity from their sins. It also describes and the conditions He came into. The "piercing cold" is a physical reflection of the spiritual situation of the world when Jesus was born: since Adam and Eve, everyone was stuck with original sin and their own sins without a sure way of forgiveness. Remember Jesus' words to Pontius Pilate near His death: "For this was I born, and for this came I into the world", meaning His birth points to His later death, which opened heaven to us and gave us the ability to share in God's divine life through our baptism.

This prayer references the Blessed Virgin Mary, the "most pure Virgin Mary," reminding us that she herself had no original sin, she was a virgin mother and remained virgin thereafter.

We can imagine St. Joseph as well, considered by many other saints to be the holiest person after the Blessed Mother. A man entrusted with taking care of and protecting Jesus and Mary themselves.

St. Andrew Advent Prayer:

Hail and blessed be the hour and moment In which the Son of God was born Of the most pure Virgin Mary, at midnight, in Bethlehem, in the piercing cold. In that hour vouchsafe, I beseech Thee, O my God, to hear my prayer and grant my desires,


