Dear Friends in Christ,

I wish all of you a very blessed Christmas! Please know of my prayers for all of you.
One of the traditions at midnight Mass that is not as well known is the Christmas proclamation. This was traditionally chanted before midnight Mass. Pope St. John Paul II restored this tradition in the 1980s. The proclamation itself is simply the first entry of the day in the *Roman Martyrology*. This book is a collection of brief accounts of the lives and deaths of all the saints in the Catholic calendar for each day of the year.

It dates back to the earliest centuries of the Church when the accounts of the deaths and the dates of death of the Roman Christian martyrs were kept by other Christians. Each day of the Martrology is dated using the ancient Roman and Greek dating system.

So, for Christmas Day, the entry for the Birth of the Lord Jesus is very specific using the various dating methods used in ancient Rome at the time. This would be chanted before midnight Mass. Here is the current English translation from the Roman Missal:

"The Twenty-fifth Day of December, when ages beyond number had run their course from the creation of the world, [The original Latin version says "In the 5199th year from the creation of the world] when God in the beginning created heaven and earth, and formed man in his own likeness; when century upon century had passed since the Almighty set his bow in the clouds after the Great Flood, as a sign of covenant and peace;

in the twenty-first century since Abraham, our father in faith, came out of Ur of the Chaldees; in the thirteenth century since the People of Israel were led by Moses in the Exodus from Egypt; around the thousandth year since David was anointed King; in the sixty-fifth week of the prophecy of Daniel; in the one hundred and ninety-fourth Olympiad; in the year seven hundred and fifty-two since the foundation of the City of Rome; in the forty-second year of the reign of Caesar Octavian Augustus, the whole world being at peace,

JESUS CHRIST, eternal God and Son of the eternal Father, desiring to consecrate the world by his most loving presence, was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and when nine months had passed since his conception, was born of the Virgin Mary in Bethlehem of Judah, and was made man: The Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ according to the flesh."

Have a blessed Christmas! Let us ask the Lord for the graces He wishes to give us during the season of His birth.




