
The Weekend Collection for February 14, 2021 was \$3,182.00

Peace of Christ,

As we begin our journey through lent, we hear in the gospel the story of Jesus tempted in the desert for forty days. We have heard this gospel story many times and we are challenged today to see this gospel in a new light. What are some of your own temptations that you struggle with in your lives? Maybe it's gossip or judging others, maybe its procrastinating, or even pride. Whatever the sin of temptation is, we have these next forty days to help us see what is keeping us from God and how we are separated from God in our lives. When we begin lent, it is custom to give something up or even add something to our daily routine. But we must be cautious in what we do, and not take on so much that we can never keep up with what we are doing. Maybe take one thing away that is hindering you from keeping the commandments and eliminate it from your daily routine. The idea of this is not to start it back up when Lent is complete, but rather eliminate what is keeping you from loving God more. Maybe it could be as simple as adding something to your prayer life. We all can benefit from something like that. As I said before, take care not to add so much that you become unable to complete those tasks.

As we begin these next six weeks, we journey together as family and continue to help each other along when time become tough. Lent is a time to grow closer to the Lord. What better way to do that than to experience the sacraments? I know the virus is still keeping a lot of people at home, but I would like to challenge those who are still away, if you feel comfortable, come home. We are invited into that covenant with God which Noah speaks about in the first reading from Genesis. This covenant or contract is something that can never be broken and reminds us that God is always near us. Let's grow closer to God this Lenten season and come home to the Lord.

We are making Mass as safe as we possibly can so that we can remain open. Masks must be worn, and social distancing will be followed. 
