Acts 4:32-35 Psalm 118 1 John 5:1-6 John 20:19-31

We have all heard the phrase doubting Thomas. Our Gospel story today encompasses Jesus appearing to His disciples. Although Thomas is not present when Jesus appears to them, they recall what had happened and tell Thomas. His famous words to them are I do not believe and will not believe until I see the nail marks in your hands and put my finger in your side. The next time Jesus appears to them He comes to Thomas and says to him; put your hand in my side, see the nail marks in my hands and feet, and Thomas came to believe. All of us at times have that reservation and have difficulty believing something until we see it. Although Thomas did not believe at first, Jesus did not hold that against him. In today's Gospel, we also see the receiving of the Holy Spirit. Jesus again gives the disciples authority over sin and tells them that if they forgive sin it will be forgiven, likewise if they do not, then it will not be forgiven. When we see Jesus do this, it is yet another example of how He is sending them forth to become the first priests and bishops of the faith. As faithful followers of God, you are called in a similar way, to be those missionary disciples which Christ can send forth to bring others to Him. As we go through this Easter season, we will continue to hear more stories of how Christ appeared to His disciples and to many other people. even if we are to be like Thomas, let us come to remember that Christ has sent us out in His vineyard to become His Missionary Disciples. Take some time today and ask yourself how you can bring others back to Church or how you can bring people closer to God through your faith.




