This weekend is a special weekend for eight of our young people in the parish. As we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, we also celebrate first communion of our young people at Christ our Hope. As we celebrate the feast of the most holy body and blood of Christ, we are called to remember that the Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith. When we use those words source and summit what do we often think of? If you have hiked to the top of a mountain, you will understand that the summit is the highest and most beautiful part of the hike. It is what you have prepared fore the entire hike at the heart of what we do, lies the Eucharist meaning that without the Eucharist our faith would just be another religion what sets us apart from other faith denominations, is the true presence of Jesus. Many other religions claim to have holy communion, but they lack the one thing that the Catholic Church holds dear and believes: namely, the understanding that the Eucharist is body blood soul and divinity of Jesus Christ himself.

At the heart of what we celebrate this weekend it is not only our belief in the Eucharist, but the joy of being able to receive Christ either for the first time or many times. How often when we receive the Eucharist, do we understand exactly what we are receiving? When we hear those words of institution that the priest says during the consecration, "this is my body this is my blood do this in remembrance of me:" we should recall those words each time we receive the Eucharist. This weekend, please pray for our young people as they receive Jesus for the first time, that they will receive Him with an open heart and that all of us can do the same each day of our lives.






