RELIGIOUS EDUCATION 2020-2021 AKA: <u>FAMILY FORMATION</u>

Family Formation is a family-based catechetical program for families with children in <u>preschool</u> through Grade 6 with an adult formation component.

How does it work?

There are two components: Families gather together on the first Sunday of the month, using the classroom lessons, monthly trained catechists teach the children in grade level classrooms while parents attend an adult teaching on the same topic. Parents are then provided all of the home lesson materials they need for the rest of the month to teach the faith to their family. The second Sunday of the month students will meet again in the classroom for an introduction to home lessons. (We added this session to assist parents with some of the topics activities and games.)

them to grow in their faith together as a family.

As we continue reading from the Gospel of John, we hear the bread of life discourse continued. I want to draw your attention to the part of the Mass that we don't often think much of; that is the Gospel acclamation. When we sing the alleluia and the verse, we are giving thanks for His word that has been spoken to us and for what we are about to hear in the Gospel. If you pay attention the verse that is sung often sums up the readings that we just heard and continue a theme throughout the Gospel passage. Today we hear the phrase, "one does not live on bread alone, but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of God." If we think of Sacred scripture as God's word, then we are called to love by that. I know it is easy to just see scripture as a something that was written thousands of years ago, but we are called to understand how this word plays into our daily lives and that it is living and effective. When we hear the beginning of our Gospel acclamation "one does not live on bread alone..." we focus on the two-fold reliance on God in the Eucharist. and God in His spoken word. How can you better listen to the Word of God in your life this week? Take the readings and spend some time with them as let God speak to your heart.


