AKA: FAMILY FORMATION

Family Formation is a family-based catechetical
program for families with children in preschool
through Grade 6 with an adult formation component.

How does it work?

There are two components: Families gather together
on the first Sunday of the month, using the classroom
lessons, monthly trained catechists teach the children
in grade level classrooms while parents attend an
adult teaching on the same topic. Parents are then
provided all of the home lesson materials they need
for the rest of the month to teach the faith to their
family. The second Sunday of the month students
will meet again in the classroom for an introduction
to home lessons. (We added this session to assist
parents with some of the topics activities and games.)

About Family Formation for Parishes

Family Formation equips the parents in our parish to
pass on the Catholic Faith to their children enabling
them to grow in their faith together as a family.

Family Formation provides a unique, challenging,
and creative curriculum that is family-based,
includes adult catechesis and training for parents,

When we are young, we often watch those who
are older than us whether it is a sibling or a
friend or a parent. We are often cautioned as
parents or people who are in positions of
authority to be cautious in what we do around
younger people because they watch our good
behaviors as well as our bad behaviors. The
mind of a child soaks us everything around it and
watches everything that happens both good and
bad.

St Paul's letter to the Ephesians tells us to be
imitators of God and reminds us that we should
remove all bitterness, fury, anger, shouting,
along with malice. These attributes cause us to
become separated from God as well as those
around us. When we get angry at a friend or a
family member, we try our best to access the
situation and find ways to reconcile with one-
another. What causes us to find ways to
reconcile with another? Often times its our
conscience telling us to apologize, or others it's
our upbringing that reminds us to not hold a
grudge, but what it should be is a reminder of
today's second reading. As we focus on what it
means to imitate God, we are called to
remember the commandments to love God and
neighbor, but also countless other examples. If
we look at St Paul's letter to the people of
Corinth, we are reminded of what true love is.
To love one-another is to eliminate all things
such as greed, envy, lust, and so many other
things. He recalls that love is patient, kind, does
and not seek things that it shouldn't. with these
in mind, how can you seek to be an imitator of
God and follow his commandments to love,
forgive, and follow after Him every day?
