RELIGIOUS EDUCATION 2020-2021 AKA: FAMILY FORMATION

Family Formation is a family-based catechetical program for families with children in <u>preschool</u> through Grade 6 with an adult formation component.

How does it work?

There are two components: Families gather together on the first Sunday of the month, using the classroom lessons, monthly trained catechists teach the children in grade level classrooms while parents attend an adult teaching on the same topic. Parents are then provided all of the home lesson materials they need for the rest of the month to teach the faith to their family. The second Sunday of the month students will meet again in the classroom for an introduction to home lessons. (We added this session to assist parents with some of the topics activities and games.)

pass on the Catholic Faith to their children enabling
them to grow in their faith together as a family.

Family Formation provides a unique, challenging, and creative curriculum that is family-based, includes adult catechesis and training for parents, is founded on the Truth and teachings of the Catholic Church, and is designed to make living the Faith a way of life and a life-long learning adventure.

Today we celebrate the Assumption of the

Blessed Virgin Mary, the Day that the church teaches that she was taken up to heaven and reunited with her beloved son Jesus. In the Eastern Rite Churches this is often referred to as the "dormition of Mary" or the falling asleep of Mary. When we think of the Blessed Mother, what do we often think of? Often one word used to describe her is Humble. Mary teaches us humility by the way she points to Jesus every time she speaks in scripture or speaks about Her Son. The way in which she lives out that humility is a way we are called to live lives of simplicity and point to Christ in all that we do. We often say that we are called to follow the commandments, to follow them we must be living the way Christ tells us both in word and deed. The way that we say we live our lives and the way that we do, must reflect one in the same. Looking at the life of Mary, we can learn how to become more simple and humble in our way of life, but also be bold to stand up for our faith the way she did. By her simple "yes" she became the mother of Christ, the Son of God. She would have been ridiculed and shunned for this, but she stood firm in what she believed and had been told by the angel. How can you commit to living more like Mary and how can you continue to simplify your way of life to become humble as the Blessed Mother?




