


As a priest celebrating the Mass is one of the most beautiful things we can do. Being able to celebrate the liturgy of the word and the liturgy of the Eucharist is such a blessing. There are many prayers that a priest will pray silently to himself during the liturgy. This was much more prominent during the Latin Rite liturgy prior to 1962 but continues today in some capacity. During the time in which the altar is set, the priest will pray the words "Blessed are you Lord God of all creation for through your goodness we have this bread and wine to offer, fruit of the earth and work of human hand it will become for us our spiritual food and drink." Shortly after that the priest will wash (purify) his hands while he says, "Lord wash me from my iniquity, cleanse me from my sins." This act is rooted in the Old Testament where the priest would purify his hands and feet before going into the "tabernacle" or the Holy of Holies (The Sanctuary). This was an outward and inward symbol of the priest purifying himself and cleansing himself before going before God.

In our Gospel this week we find Jesus making an example of the scribes and Pharisees by reciting a verse from the Prophet Isaiah: "This people honors me with their lips but their hearts are far from me, in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines human precepts." Jesus reminds them that they cling to human tradition. While we all should strive to purify ourselves, we should not do so just to find ourselves in the same situation again. What do we need to purify ourselves of today and how will we ask God's forgiveness today? Take some time this week and ask God to purify you and cling to your faith, not human tradition as the scribes and Pharisees.




