


This is our final weekend for Masses at St Mary of the Snows until Memorial Day. We look forward to opening again in the Spring. As summer draws to a close and we return to our jobs, daily routine, we must remember to take the time needed for us to be open to God and His plan for us. Each of us are called but we must be able to be able to slow down and listen to His plan for us.

Today we hear the story of Jesus healing a man who was deaf and had a speech impediment. Jesus did this by outing His finger in His ear and touching His tongue. You are probably thinking that this is rather an odd way for Jesus to heal someone. While this is not the ordinary way Jesus usually heals someone, we can surmise that that Jesus did this out of love. We can sum this healing up in one word intimacy, not the romantic kind or sentimental kind, but the compassionate kind of a God that loves His people. to understand this love, the one thing that we must do is to remain open to God's love for us. So often it is easy to shut out God from our loves, which society is telling us to do in so many ways. But we must remain strong hearted and open in all that we do. The one word that Jesus uses to heal this man is the word "Ephphatha" or to "be open." How can you remain open to God's love for you? Be willing to open your hearts this week and let God in those moments when you feel far from Him. Those are the moments that we need Him the most.


