What does it mean to give from the heart? For the widow in the Gospel today, she gave two small coins which was all that she had, but she still contributed. As Jesus says in the Gospel today, she gave more than everyone else, because she gave from her heart rather than the surplus of her wealth.

Over the last few weeks, I have been giving a review of our financial status in the parish. While we have been blessed to have a few bequests in the last year, we are still in need of donations to keep a sound financial BACKBONE for the parish. Over the years I have had people ask why weekly donations mean so much and why people have been asked to give more. To state this simply, weekly offerings go into our operating account which pays bills, salary, and other expenditures. Just as a husband and wife combine their funds to pay for the expenses incurred with their mortgage and other expenses, the church relies on the generosity of the parishioners to remain financially sound.

Between assessments, salary, utilities, and other ordinary expenses, we have incurred \$234,773.39 this fiscal year. This fiscal year's ordinary income from collections, votive's, Hope Appeal overage & bulletin advertising, is \$173,107.45.

Our Net Ordinary Income is -61,665.94.


We received a \$31,000.00 extra ordinary income grant last year from the government (Paycheck Protections program) which helped but we will not receive one going forward. This helped offset the cost for utilities and salaries.

I would like to thank you for your continued support, but also take this time to ask for your help by accessing what you give currently, and really look at it, if you can give more (if possible). I said when I came to Christ Our Hope that I did not enjoy asking for money, but this is for the betterment of our parish community, so that we can thrive both spiritually and financially. In the next year we will have to do many maintenance repairs to our buildings so that they can remain in good condition. I will be calling on each of you to be as generous as you can during this next year.

Each of you are a gift to this parish and have a profound effect on how this community runs. It is up to each of us as parishioners to help as much as possible so that we can continue to pray, and worship together as a community. I would ask that in this next year, you look at what you are able to give and truly give from the heart what you are able.


