
As we continue our preparations toward Christmas, our readings begin to shift from apocalyptic to hopeful. This week in our Gospel, we hear a historical account of who was in public office during the time before Jesus. As the time for the birth of Christ grows closer, we begin to see much more hope in our readings, and the presentation of a Messiah is coming forth. This week's Gospel acclamation reminds us to "prepare the way of the Lord and make straight His paths." These are the words of St John the Baptist who is also awaiting the coming of the Messiah. As John is in the desert, he waits for the word of the Lord to come to him. During his time of preparation and waiting, he grows stronger in the spirit. As many of us would grow during a time of separation and silence, John uses that time to grow in prayer. Waiting is often a difficult thing. Like a child waiting for Christmas, we too wait with ready hearts to greet the Lord when He comes. This central theme of Advent allows us to prepare and grow spiritually just as St John the Baptist did in the desert. With the renewed sense of hope God gives us each year, we can learn to grow in holiness and strengthen our love for God so that we can prepare ourselves to meet Him.


