Dear Parishioners,

Our first reading from the Book of Sirach reminds us that we are tested by our words while similarly in the Gospel, Jesus says "from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks." It is very easy to reveal what is important to you by looking at what your thoughts and desires are. If we kept track of everything we said in a day, we would find that our hearts are filled with many things such as gratitude, worry, frustration, ambition or love. What thoughts do we have in our mind at this moment? For all of us, that is going to vary at different points throughout the day. We are called to look at our own hearts and ask ourselves where our desires lie, and what is on our heart right now.

I know the difficulty and the conflict happening in Ukraine is on many of our hearts. I would ask that all of us take some time and pray for Ukraine, for the people caught in the middle of this war, and those who are protecting their homes and families.






