Dear Parishioners,

I wanted to give you all an update on where we stand with our Hope appeal. As I mentioned at the end of our campaign in December, our goal was \$17667.65. At the start of the campaign in September many people started contributing and we were off to a great start. By December 31 we had just made our goal. Since December we have had several people continue to give so generously that we have surpassed our goal. To date we have received \$24,639.00. As I mentioned during the campaign, we would receive 100 percent of our overage back which means that we are receiving just under \$6500 dollars back. This is something that we should be very proud of. By receiving this amount back, we can do some things that we normally would not be able to do without that

A number of people have been asking since I arrived here a year ago about the bell system here at St. Josephs. The current system we have is an electronic bell system that has not operated since about 2016. The computer program was created in the mid 1990s and needs to be updated along with the amplifier and the speakers. The speakers are original to the system which was installed in the 1970s. Given the climate in which they are in, it is in the best interest to replace them if we are going to be replacing the system.

With our return of \$6439.00 dollars from the Hope appeal we are over halfway to upgrading this bell system which costs around \$11,000 dollars for new speakers, amplifier, and new bell system. I have spoken to numerous companies, and they are all around the same price for replacement of this system. I am asking if anyone would be interested in helping to memorialize this system in memory of their loved ones.

It would be great to hear the sound of the bells playing before and after each Mass. The bells not only can be played for Masses, but also for funerals, weddings, and other special times during the year. Thank you for your consideration.
