Dear Parishioners,

As we come to the third Sunday of Lent, we hear in the Gospel the parable of the fig tree. We may ask ourselves how we are doing in our Lenten journey. Maybe we are doing well, and our spiritual lives are thriving, or maybe we are not doing as well as we would hope. We are called not to fear and to trust that the Lord will guide our hearts towards Him this Lenten season. The parable of the fig tree is not the one we are used to, but rather, we hear how the fig tree has not blossomed and it should be uprooted and discarded. Jesus reminds the farmer that God works in ways that may not be known to us at first so leave the tree one more season so that it may thrive.

This is a great analogy for our spiritual lives. Often, we do not see how God works in and through us to make us thrive. It takes time and patience so that we can thrive even if we find ourselves falling short. As God works in us this Lenten season, let us take the time to examine where He has been with us and where we have turned away from Him.

Monday April 11th we will have "The Light is on for You" campaign throughout the Diocese. This means that from 4-7pm, Confessions will be available in many parishes throughout the diocese. Christ Our Hope at St Joseph's will have confessions on April 11th from 4-7PM. I would encourage you take the opportunity to come to confession whether it has been a few weeks or many years. God is waiting to give you His forgiveness and His mercy.




