

Dear Parishioners,

As we enter into this most sacred time of the Liturgical Year, we take the time to prepare ourselves for what is to come. This week, we will journey with Jesus from His triumphant entry into Jerusalem, to sharing a last meal with His disciples, to His Passion and death on the Cross, and ultimately to the Resurrection. How quickly we will go from singing Hosanna to the Son of David and carrying palm branches, to yelling "Crucify Him". As we go through this week, the mood and the emotions intensify, and it becomes reality how difficult this week was for Christ.

Jesus knew that He was entering a sacred time and that all He did over the three years of His public ministry would lead up to this point and ultimately to the Cross. The one word we can use to describe this week is "love". Each day this week, we will listen to another story that reveals Jesus' love for us, and we will see just another facet of what it means that He is the Lamb of God who loves us and takes away our sins.

As we go through this week, I encourage you to slow down and join us for each liturgy. Palm Sunday we will distribute and bless the palms which signify His triumphant entry into Jerusalem. Holy Thursday, we turn to the most solemn part of the week as we begin the Sacred Triduum. This day we will celebrate the Last Supper of Jesus and hear how Jesus washes the disciples feet, an act of humility which will be both challenged and embraced. Friday, we will recall the death of Jesus and have an opportunity to venerate the cross and a time of prayer. Saturday, we will recall the time of waiting in darkness at the Easter Vigil. During this time, we celebrate the Light of Christ as it is renewed and given to each person. Finally on Easter Sunday we recall His Resurrection and triumph over Sin and Death.

Take some time this week and join us for each of our Liturgies. May you all have a Blessed Holy Week.

Holy Thursday 7 PM at St. Joseph's Good Friday Service 2 PM at St. Joseph's Stations of the Cross 6 PM at St. Joseph's Easter Vigil 8 PM at St. Joseph's Easter Sunday Mass 8 AM at St. Patrick's and 10AM at St. Joseph's.


