Dear Parishioners,

Alleluia He is Risen! Today we as a Church celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ who has defeated sin and death and won the true victory for all of His people. In the Gospel scene today, we would imagine there to be a calm and reflective encounter, but instead we see panic and grief. Mary has come to the tomb with Simon Peter and with John to find the tomb empty. Realizing that the tomb is empty they become frightened and concerned. As the Gospel recounts, "They did not yet understand the scripture that He had to rise from the dead." We recognize that Jesus rose from the dead and appears to his disciples and to many others through the duration of the New Testament. Over the next few weeks, we will listen to the encounters of the risen Christ and how He appear to his followers.

This is a great time to reflect on our own personal encounters with Jesus. Not only during the last few weeks of Lent but also, in the days to come. We know how Christ works in and through ourselves and others to show us His love and Mercy, but now He continues that relationship that was kindled. How has Christ made Himself present in your life? Take some time to reflect on that. Christ presents Himself in many ways that we may not see on a daily basis. Take some time to look back on the day and recall how you saw Christ working in those moments of good, but also the difficult moments. How can we see Christ in our daily lives? 
