This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus. In the Gospel this weekend, we hear the parable of the feeding of the five thousand. This Gospel prefigures what Jesus will do for not only His disciples, but all of us at the last supper by giving us His Body and Blood as the food which nourishes us. This Feast should remind us of not only the importance of the Eucharist as nourishment, but also how the Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith.

As I mentioned in the Homily last week, there is no way to formally explain how the gifts of bread and wine transform into the Body and Blood of Jesus, but it is rather a mystery. We know that during the Mass prayers are said in which, at a certain point, the priest calls down the Holy Spirit to transform the ordinary bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus. This also reminds us of the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. It's difficult to think that to so many people this is just a symbol of Jesus' Body and Blood rather than the true Body and Blood of Jesus. Let us pray this week that over the course of the next year the Eucharist will continue to be the source and summit of our faith, and that the Eucharist will guide us in all that we do.

This weekend we also celebrate Father's Day. The role of the father is often to provide for his family and to be able to be that rock for those around him. In the Gospel, we hear how Jesus feeds the five thousand and provides for the needs of those who follow Him. Let us pray this week for all fathers, and those who are in a fatherly role, that they may continue to lead those around them and use the nourishment of the Eucharist as the foundation of their strength and guidance.

We also welcome Sr. Anisia Muthoni, who will be speaking about the St Francis Ministry which provides education and basic needs to orphaned and poor children in Kenya. The Parish has always been so welcoming to those who come for Mission talks. We warmly welcome her this weekend to our Parish.


