



Dear Parishioners,

I will be away this Monday through Friday at a conference at Villanova University in Pennsylvania. A number of other newly ordained priests and seminarians will join priests and seminarians from other dioceses for a week long conference on various aspects of parish administration. One would think that after seven years in seminary, a priest would have the necessary information to run a parish. The one thing I have learned from my time here so far at Christ Our Hope, is that I learn something new every day. One part of priesthood many people do not understand is the administration side of the parish. While the parish is largely made up of liturgical celebrations, nothing can occur without the proper administration and management which is often taken care of during the week. Managing finances, maintenance issues, pastoral encounters, and diocesan events are just some of the things that are managed throughout the week. These are just some of the topics that will be covered during this week long conference.

As a newly ordained priest, someone asked me, "How do I talk to God"? I think that is such a great question whether it is coming from a child or from a lifelong catholic. The answer will vary for each person and continue to vary through each person's spiritual life. Part of talking to God should just be a conversation, but as we all know talking to a person who is not "physically" present with us is much more difficult. In our first reading from Genesis, we hear a conversation between Abraham and God similar to the various prophets throughout the Old Testament. This was the way in which God made Himself known to His people, through prophets. In the New Testament, we see God revealing Himself through Jesus and teaches us how to pray. Prayer is the center of our spiritual lives and gives us the strength to continue our journey.

For all of us, prayer can be very different. Each of us have our own ways and means to be able to pray. The one thing that unites us is the commitment to it. We get out what we put in. As harsh as that may sound, we must have the conviction to put effort into our prayer lives if we want to receive something out of it. Take some time this week and set that time aside to pray no matter if it is 10 minutes or an hour, each of us has the time to pray and have that simply conversation with God.
