Dear Parishioners,

Much will be required of the person  
entrusted with much. Those are the words  
we hear from Luke's Gospel this weekend.  
What has God entrusted you with? For  
each of us that will be different on some  
level but at the heart of what we are given  
is our faith. Our faith should be looked at as  
a gift and something that is so precious to  
us and not just thrown aside like something  
we don't care about. Most of the time, our  
faith is handed on to us by our parents  
which God cultivates in us over time. "This  
light of faith is entrusted to be kept burning  
brightly" as we hear in the Rite of Baptism.  
Once we are old enough, we chose to  
continue that faith through the Sacrament of  
the Eucharist and then the Sacrament of  
Confirmation.

We know that we do not keep the faith  
to ourselves, we put our faith into action by  
choosing the correct thing to do with it. The  
parable of the Good Steward which we hear  
this weekend reminds us to not only be  
ready, but also stay faithful to the gift that  
God gives us and always listen to God's  
voice. We also need to be ready to share  
our gift of faith. For many of us, it can be  
intimidating to share things about our faith  
as often we are not open to sharing stories  
about our faith. If that is you this week, take  
some time to open your heart to what God  
has done for you over the last few weeks  
and reflect on how God has walked with  
you on your own journey of faith? We don't  
have to look very far to realize that God  
walks with us and those around us to show  
us His presence, but we do have to look  
and pay attention to the signs around us.

So much is required of us each day of  
our lives, take the opportunity to make sure  
that your faith is at the heart of your  
decisions and that you share the gift of faith  
that God gave you.
