Labor Day Weekend (9/4/2022) will be the final mass of the year at St. Mary of the Snows until Spring. See you in 2023! Dear Parishioners,

"Which of you wishing to construct a tower does not first sit down and calculate the cost"? In this weeks Gospel, we focus on various themes from taking up your cross, discipleship, and proper fiscal preparations in our lives. We all know what it means to take up our cross and face the challenges each day in our lives. How often do we take the chance to really plan out a situation? So often we have to face a situation as it comes.

This week I have been calculating a few things at our parishes that we have done over the last year. Some of those things include putting a new roof on St. Patrick's Church and the Thrift Shop so that we can continue to worship and focus on a part of our outreach ministry with the Thrift Shop. We have put a new Bell System at St. Joseph's Church which you can hear each day before Mass begins and at 12 noon, and 6 PM. Some of these things are more maintenance driven, but they are also part of our mission.

Maintenance and mission are two aspects of our church that we should focus on when making decisions and calculating the cost of a situation. Over the past few weeks, we have been having some water leaks in Gill Hall at St. Joseph's. At closer evaluation by a contractor, the roof is in need of some work to make it functional for Faith Formation this year. What I am considering is to replace the roof so that we can continue our mission for our children. There is much more that needs to be done on this building if we are to bring it from maintenance mode to mission mode. Maintenance means that we are just doing the bare minimum to keep the building open, whereas mission is driven by the mission of the Parish as a whole.

What I would like to propose is that we start to look at situations as mission oriented meaning that we are not just doing maintenance on a building, but looking ahead to how we can deepen our faith, and our mission as a Church. We also need to be able to have a place where we can gather for faith enrichment, have dinners as a parish, and gather as the Christ Our Hope Parish family.


