Boxes can be found at the back of the churches for any donations. Your support is greatly appreciated.


Religious Education 2022-2023



FAITH OF A MUSTARD SEED



Dear Parishioners,

As you know, Gill Hall has needed some maintenance and upkeep. We are in the process of continuing that work. So far the roof has been completed and we are now moving to address the ceiling and insulation issues in the building. In the process we found that there is still old knob and tube wiring which should be removed for safety concerns. This will be an ongoing task throughout the winter. I will keep you updated as we make progress.

This week in our gospel, we hear the parable of the mustard seed. I have never been much in the way of a gardener, but it is fascinating to look at the life of a plant especially the mustard seed. The mustard seed transforms from the smallest seed into a rather large tree. The disciples first say in the gospel today "Lord increase our faith". For all of us, we can benefit from this simple prayer. Asking the Lord to increase our faith allows us to simply rely on the Lord, but also to realize that we need to change something in our lives.

To increase our faith, what do we need to do? For most of us it starts with prayer. As we live out our lives of missionary discipleship, we are called to evaluate where we stand. In the first reading from the prophet Habakkuk, we hear someone crying out asking the Lord to listen. So much distraction and misery are before him, but he does the one thing he knows that he can do, simply ask the Lord for help. Similar to the gospel, "Lord increase my faith". For each of us, we are at various points in our faith journey. This is why the parable of the mustard seed is such a perfect image. Whether we have faith the size of a mustard seed or even larger we know that faith can be cultivated into something great. It just needs time and effort.

How much time and effort will you dedicate to your faith this week?


