Please start saving your shoe boxes, we will also have boxes available at the back of church. There will be a general donation box for individually


donated items in the church.

This week we celebrate the feast of All Saints Day and All Souls Day. All Saints Day will be celebrated on Tuesday at St Josephs at 8:30 AM and 6PM. All Saints Day is a Holy Day of Obligation this year. All Souls Day is not a Holy Day of Obligation and will be celebrated at 8:30 AM at St Patrick's in Forestport. During this Mass, we remember all of our loved ones who have died this year and pray for them. We will continue to pray for them throughout the month of November.

Over the next couple of months, we will welcome Dc Michael Lieber who is from the Diocese of Ogdensburg. He will be assisting at a few of the Masses as well as preaching every so often to get practice and feedback from another parish other than his own. The Diocese of Ogdensburg does not automatically give their deacons the faculty to preach, they must give a number of practice homilies in both their home parish and another parish. Please welcome him in the coming weeks.

Our readings this week draw our attention to following Christ and prove just how unpredictable Jesus can be throughout His travels. If you remember back when Pope Francis was elected Pope, how unpredictable he was and still is today. When his security detail told him to go here or there, he immediately went to the people he thought needed to see him. Other times he allowed children to run right up to him during services and he embraced them. This is very similar to what Jesus did in the gospel today by disregarding any laws or safety concerns and going to stay at the house of the chief tax collector, Zacchaeus.

This encounter completely alters the life of Zacchaeus and makes him realize that what he is doing is wrong. He tells Jesus that if he has stolen anything from anyone that he will repay them four times over. This simple act on Jesus' part changes the outlook on Zacchaeus's life and shows him the path that he should be following. What path have you chosen in your life? Even if at times we choose the wrong path, this gospel shows us that the outlook can change no matter what we have done. We look to the conversion of so many of the saints and figures in the Bible, from St Paul to the repentant thief who was crucified next to Jesus. Each of us can change and understand what road we need to be on. What road will you take this week?




