Dear Parishioners,

What are some of the things that we invest in? For most of us, we invest in things that we enjoy or that allow us to benefit from them.

When we invest money into a stock portfolio or a bank, we expect that over time it will gain interest and yield more than what we first invested. When gardening we invest money in seed, and time into making things perfect so that the seed can grow. We make sure that we take the time to care for the plants in the proper way so that they can yield a fruitful harvest.

Both examples have a similar underlying theme, when we invest in something we expect that it will give us something in return. How often do we look at this mindset and put it into practice with our spiritual lives? Investing is not something that we can just do once and forget, we need to watch the market and switch things around. In most cases we have a financial advisor to help us with those things. The same for planting, once a seed grows, we must cultivate the soil around it so that it can continue growing. We must eliminate anything that causes it harm and prune the leaves that are dead around it so that it can flourish. In the final line of our Gospel this weekend Luke speaks of perseverance. This is a trait that must be followed if we are looking to invest in anything.

When we invest in our spiritual lives, we are in it for the long haul. Even if there are times when we feel as though our relationship with God is lukewarm, we continue to invest the time in prayer, reflection, and study. If we desire our relationship to grow, we need to cultivate it, give it the time, and work at it even if we think it is lost. Mother Teresa went through a period of what she called "spiritual dryness". The time in her life when she didn't hear God speaking to her was the most difficult part of her life, but she was able to continue to invest the time and effort in her relationship with God.


