If you are still looking for something to fill a spiritual New Year's resolution or a goal for your spiritual life this year, I would invite you to take a look at two of these podcasts. Fr. Mike Schmitz is a priest of the Diocese of Duluth Minnesota who is a renowned speaker and writer and has started two podcasts that dive deep into the Bible and the Catechism of the Catholic Church.
