Dear Parishioners,

I would like to take an opportunity to thank those who came and helped clean up Gill Hall. As you can imagine, there is much updating that is required on that building and so much which we have already done. We have put a new roof and overhang on the building to make sure it will not leak anymore. We have installed new LED lighting as well as a new ceiling and will be installing the kitchen floor this coming week. I want to take this opportunity to again thank those who have either helped physically or monetarily over the last few months to make these much-needed repairs possible. There is still much work that can be done in Gill Hall and on the Rectory, but as I need to continually remind myself "Rome wasn't built in a day."

Other projects which will need to be considered between now and the end of summer, are the front and side entrances to the rectory which have been showing wear and are now in need of repair. We will also be looking into getting some quotes for stonework on the foundations for St. Joseph's Church as well as St. Mary of the Snows in Otter Lake. As you know, once cracks in stone are visible, water can begin to erode these and create more problems. We, as Christ our Hope, need to preserve these beautiful buildings so that they can continue to be a home and such an integral part of our three communities.

As we count down the days to the start of Lent, we should start to consider what we will be giving up. This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday. There will be two opportunities to come to Mass and receive Ashes. Mass in the morning will be held at St Patrick's in Forestport at the normal time of 8:30 AM, and the evening Mass will be at St Joseph's Boonville at 6PM. This is a beautiful way to start our Lenten journey. As we prepare for Lent, we also consider something to give up, or something to add to our prayer lives. It can be either one or both but should not be unachievable. Maybe we give something up that we do too much of or try to read a chapter from scripture each day during Lent. For each of us, our Lenten journey may look different, but we know that this is a perfect time to journey with the Lord and make Him a part of our daily routine. 
