Dear Parishioners,

April 3rd we will have confessions here at Christ Our Hope, (St Joseph's) from 4pm-7pm. I will be in the confessional for anyone who wants to go to confession. Whether it has been a couple weeks or a number of years, it is a great opportunity to come to the Lord and ask for His forgiveness before Easter.

We hear in the Gospel, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die." Do you believe this? What does it mean to believe? We profess what we as Catholics believe each time, we pray the Creed. Today in the Gospel, Jesus asks Martha, the Brother of Lazarus do you believe? That question can be asked of each of us as well. Maybe in another way, how well do we believe? Each of us at times have trouble believing and need a sense of hope in times of distress. We focus on the one thing that we as Catholics know best, Resurrection.

What does this mean? Our readings shift from speaking about desolation and temptation, to focusing on Resurrection. When we hear the word Resurrection we think of, New life, Hope, and Light. I always love the point in the Easter Vigil when we see the Paschal Candle brought into the darkened Church and the light of Christ is spread throughout the entire Church. This gives us that sense of Hope as Christ reminds us that He is that true light of the world.

The prophet Ezekiel reminds us that God will open the graves of all who have died and have us rise from them. St. Paul reminds us that the spirit of Christ dwells in each of us and we are called to make that known to those around us. We are called to believe in our catholic faith now more than ever. To remain close to Christ and to believe in the presence of Christ who remains with us on our journey throughout our lives and calls us to follow Him.

Do you believe this? Ask yourself that question this week, and reflect on where you need to grow to come to believe that even more.
