Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, Bishop Lucia will be here to Confirm five of our young people. This is an exciting time for our parish to receive Bishop Lucia as well as to pray for five of our High School Students who will be receiving the fullness of the Holy Spirit through the Sacrament of Confirmation. Our Confirmation students have been preparing over the last two years by attending class each week as well as being part of our parish and community.

This weekend, we also celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday which always falls on the Second Sunday of Easter. In our reading today, we hear how the twelve devoted themselves to teaching and communal life. We also hear from in the Acts of the Apostles, the beginnings of the first "Church." When we think of church we often think of the building and the things that make up the physical building. In the early church, the disciples would often gather in the home to share a meal together and break open the scriptures to those around them. This is very fitting if you look back in the History of Boonville and how the "Church" came about in this area. In the late 1800s, there was beginning to show a need for a church in this area. Priests from the surrounding churches would come on a monthly basis and gather at someone's house prior to this physical structure being opened in 1886. When we think of Church, it is much more than just a building, it is the people who make up the church community. It's easy to say that the church is where the building is, but as we know that is simply a structure or a place to worship. The community, as a whole, is what makes up the Church and is part of the Church Universal throughout the world.

We are Christ Our Hope parish community in Boonville, Forestport, and Otter Lake. Our presence as "Church" is much more than just a physical building, it is the family which makes up part of the Church Universal. We remember that Church is not just the four walls that make up these buildings but rather what happens when we are sent forth from these buildings. As the priest says, "Go in peace", we are being sent forth as the disciples were in the Gospel today. As we hear in the Gospel, we are called to proclaim Jesus as the risen Christ. Even though we may doubt at times, we have the conviction of St. Thomas to proclaim the words, "My Lord and My God."

Let's take the opportunity this week to explore our faith in deeper means so that we can experience the risen Christ, be a part of the Church Universal and be sent as Christ sent His disciples into the world to teach and preach to the people throughout the world.


