Dear Parishioners.

As we celebrate the Seventh Sunday of Easter we are drawn to the theme of witnessing. In our first reading from the Book of Acts we hear Jesus remind His disciples "You will be my witnesses." As we continue to hear from the Acts of the Apostles, we should know that the author of the book of Acts is thought to be the same writer who authored the Gospel Luke. We can see very similar writing themes as well as direct connections between them. When we consider the idea of being witnesses first, we must realize what it meant to be a witness in the first century. After the death of Jesus, many areas forbade the speaking or teaching of anything that Jesus had taught. We often see some of the first martyrs in this time due to the disobeying of this decree. When we look before us and see the countless martyrs who died proclaiming the faith such as St. Steven, who was the First Catholic martyr. He was an ordained deacon who stood in the face of the rabbinical courts and proclaimed the teachings of Jesus. As he was martyred, he echoed a prayer of forgiveness towards his attackers. The same as Christ did on the cross.

To this day, we still have martyrs such as Blessed Miguel Pro and even more modern-day martyrs who may not be recognized by the Church yet. Blessed Miguel Pro was a Mexican Jesuit priest who was martyred for being a catholic priest in 1927. His final words before he was martyred were "Viva Cristo Rey" (Long live Christ the King).

As we focus on being a witness this weekend, our readings give us a glance of what it means to witness Christ in our daily lives as the disciples did. We also see the countless martyrs who gave their lives so that we can have faith and be witnesses as well. That does not mean that we are all going to be martyrs, rather a simple way to look at it is how can we be witnesses to Christ's Resurrection every day of our lives? Do we talk about the faith with our friends or family? Do we learn more about our faith when we have the opportunity? Do we go deeper in our spiritual relationship with God through prayer? For each of us, witnessing will look a little different, that doesn't mean we are not called to be witnesses of the Faith as Christ calls His disciples to be.
