Dear Parishioners,

June 11th is the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus. That is also the time we will be reintroducing the Chalice at Mass. As you know, the Chalice with the Precious Blood was removed during COVID. We will reintroduce the Chalice during the weekend Masses starting June 10th and 11th.

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. It is through simple signs of bread and wine that the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity is made present to us. Today we focus on the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ who is fully present always in the Eucharist. Just as God gave the Israelites manna in the desert, we too are given food to sustain us and nourish us in our daily lives.

We hear in the Gospel today that, "I am the living bread that comes down from heaven." Christ gave us the Eucharist as a remembrance of Him on the night before He was to die. On Holy Thursday we celebrate what is called the Institution of the Eucharist. On this day Jesus said the same words which the priest says at mass during the Eucharistic prayer: He took bread broke it and gave it to His disciples saying, "Take this all of you and eat of it, this is My Body which will be given up for you." "In a similar way when supper was ended, He took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to His disciples saying, "Take this all of you and drink from it, for this is the chalice of My Blood, the Blood of the new and eternal covenant which will be poured out for many do this in remembrance of me." These words are the words which Jesus said and are the words used at mass to transform the ordinary bread and wine into the true presence of Jesus Christ. Jesus gave us His body to eat as food for the journey, as well as spiritual nourishment. We come before Jesus in the presence of our families and friends to listen to the word of God and then be nourished at His table. We are nourished by listening to God's word in scripture and then the receiving of Holy Communion.

During this week, I invite you to spend some time with Jesus in prayer at home either with family or alone, or even in church in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. How is God giving you food for the journey? How is He feeding you spiritually? God gives to each of us the nourishment we each need. How is God nourishing you this week?
