Dear Parishioners,

Psalm 89:2-3, 16-19 is where our Responsorial Psalm is taken from this weekend. This psalm is a powerful reflection on the unchanging nature of God's love and faithfulness. As I meditate on these verses, I am struck by the assurance they bring and the reminder of God's covenant with His people.

The psalmist begins by declaring that God's love stands firm forever and His faithfulness is established in heaven itself. This truth is a source of great comfort and hope. In a world that is constantly changing and full of uncertainty, it is reassuring to know that God's love for us is unwavering. His faithfulness extends beyond the limits of time and space, reaching to the highest heavens. The psalmist goes on to mention the covenant God made with David, His chosen servant. This covenant promised that David's dynasty would endure forever, with a descendant sitting on the throne eternally. This covenant is a testament to God's faithfulness and His commitment to His people. It reminds us that God keeps His promises and remains steadfast in His love for us.

The psalmist continues by highlighting the blessedness of those who acclaim God and walk in His presence. This is a call to live a life of praise and worship, recognizing the goodness and righteousness of God. 
