Dear Parishioners,

By this time you have probably heard that the Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse has reached an agreement and is nearing an end to the Chapter 11 reorganization. Just to give a brief overview of where the Diocese began in 2020 with this process and where we have come. In 2020, the Diocese of Syracuse was hit with a number of lawsuits stemming from sexual abuse incidents that had happened over the last 30 years or more. In June of 2020, Bishop Lucia met with the priests of the Diocese of Syracuse to converse about the possibility of filing Chapter 11 reorganization. We spoke at length about the various possibilities and came to the conclusion that this was the best financial option for the Diocese, the victims, and everyone involved. Filing for Chapter 11 reorganization meant that the Diocese would be able to assure a fair settlement for the victims while still being able to operate financially. Over the past 3 years the Syracuse Diocese has worked with and been represented by a panel of lawyers who have helped us through this process. Over the last three years, meetings have taken place to discuss a settlement for the 411 sexual abuse claims against the Diocese of Syracuse. The Diocese, as well as the lawyers, have looked at each of these cases and have found theme to be credible.

Last Thursday, the pastors of the Diocese met with Bishop Lucia and learned that an agreement had been made on a financial settlement. Throughout the past three years, Bishop Lucia, the Chancellor of the Diocese, Danielle Cummings, and our attorneys have met in litigation with the victims creditors committee to discuss a financial settlement. This settlement would be compensation for the abuse that occurred to the victims and their families.

The Diocese of Syracuse and the creditors committee has reached a settlement of \$100 million dollars diocesan-wide. A letter from Bishop Lucia has been included in this week's bulletin. I will be speaking at all masses this weekend explaining the breakdown of how the settlement will be made. This week, I will be calling a meeting with our Trustees and Finance Committee to further discuss our portion of the payment. Please know that I am being as transparent as I can and as you know I am always open to questions and concerns that you may have. I would ask for your prayers at this time for the victims and the Diocese of Syracuse as we continue the healing process and move forward.


