Dear Parishioners,

The Transfiguration is a significant event in the life of Jesus that holds great importance in the understanding of His divinity and the revelation of God's glory. It is a moment where Jesus' true nature is revealed to His closest disciples, Peter, James, and John, as they witness His radiant transformation on the mountain. The Transfiguration is seen as a prefiguration of the glory that awaits believers in heaven. It serves as a confirmation of Jesus' identity as the Son of God and the fulfillment of the prophecies of the Old Testament. The event takes place after Jesus reveals to His disciples that He will suffer, die, and rise again, emphasizing the trans formative power of His sacrifice.

encounter with God in the Catholic Faith. In the Transfiguration, Jesus ascends the mountain with His disciples, representing their journey towards a deeper union with God. As they reach the mountaintop, Jesus is transfigured before their eyes; His face shines like the sun, and His clothes become dazzling white. This transformation signifies the divine nature of Jesus and His connection to the Father. The presence of Moses and Elijah during the Transfiguration is significant in the Catholic understanding. Moses represents the law, and Elijah represents the prophets, both of whom point to Jesus as the fulfillment of God's plan. This encounter with the law and the prophets confirms Jesus' role as the fulfillment of the Old Testament covenant and the ultimate revelation of God's will.

The mountain is often considered a symbol of the

Peter's response to the Transfiguration reflects the human struggle to comprehend the divine. He suggests building three tents for Jesus. Moses, and Elijah, not fully understanding the significance of the moment. However, God's voice from the cloud instructs the disciples to listen to Jesus, emphasizing that He is the ultimate authority and source of divine revelation. The Transfiguration serves as a source of hope and encouragement in our journey of faith. It reminds us that, just as Jesus was transformed on the mountain, we too can experience a transformation through our union with him. This transformation is not limited to a physical change but encompasses a spiritual renewal and the gradual conforming to the image of Christ.

The Transfiguration also highlights the importance of prayer and contemplation in the spiritual life. Jesus retreats to the mountain to pray before His transfiguration, emphasizing the need to set aside time for prayer and communion with God. Through prayer, we seek to encounter the divine and experience a glimpse of God's glory, just as the disciples did on the mountain.

This weekend, as we celebrate the Transfiguration, It confirms Jesus' identity as the Son of God, the fulfillment of the Old Testament prophecies, and the ultimate source of divine revelation. It serves as a source of hope and encouragement for believers, reminding them of the trans formative power of their faith and the importance of prayer and contemplation in their journey towards union with God.


