Dear Parishioners,

As I mentioned last week in my column there are various costs that affect our finances in the parish. As stated, we are one parish "corporation" as Christ Our Hope not three individual parishes. We pay bills as one parish and are assessed by the Diocese of Syracuse on certain costs as a parish, not individual corporations. Throughout the Diocese, this is becoming more and more prevalent with the dwindling number of priests and Catholics in our diocese.

The Diocese of Syracuse is comprised of seven counties from northern Oneida to Binghamton, and Syracuse, Utica and Rome. In those areas, there are 120 parishes that are served by approximately 75 priests. This means that statistically every priest will have at least two parishes. The other side of the coin is also the age of the priests. Currently there are 20 priests under the age of 65. This is becoming rather difficult to serve the many parishes we have. Many people have offered solutions such as "we should get priests from other countries or from missions". The difficulties with this is getting the proper paperwork, visas, and going through the red tape with immigration to get people into the U.S. As we look at our 120 parishes in our Diocese, we all have noticed that the pews are not being filled as they were 20-50 years ago. This is something that needs to shift and we as "Church" need to assess how we can get people back into our pews. This is just a brief look at the make-up of our Diocese and the difficulties of filling parishes with priests that we do not have.

Back to Finances for a moment, each month, we are assessed by the Diocese for a total anywhere between \$4500-\$5900. This expense includes Property Insurance for each of our buildings. Each building is assessed just like our homes are and we pay into this as a group policy under the Diocese. Other costs include group disability, health, and pension which are group policies similar to our property insurance. Another expense is in the technology field. Each parish has a firewall that is managed by the Diocese for security purposes to protect not only our finances, but also each of our computers on our campus. This is managed by the Diocese and is not negotiable. Lastly, as a parish we pay into a group policy for retirement of priests and lay people. Each parish is assessed on this to pay into the retirement fund for priests and lay people throughout our Diocese. There is also a small amount of fees that we pay each month for the Diocese to manage all of this. This is a basic overview of what we pay each month to the Diocese and is non-negotiable. I hope this gives a better understanding to what it means when I speak about Diocesan assessment's.


