

In Our Gospel this weekend, we are presented with a powerful and transformative moment in



the ministry of Jesus. This passage highlights the calling of the first disciples - Simon, Andrew, James, and John - and their immediate response to Jesus' invitation to follow him. One of the key themes that emerges from this passage is the concept of immediate obedience and radical trust. When Jesus approaches Simon and Andrew, he simply says, "Come, follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." Without hesitation or questioning, they leave their nets behind and follow Jesus. Similarly, when Jesus calls out to James and John, they too abandon their fishing nets and their father to join him. This demonstrates the disciples' willingness to prioritize their relationship with Jesus above all else.

Another important aspect of this passage is the idea of transformation. Jesus promises to make the disciples "fishers of men," indicating that their lives will be radically changed as they become instruments of God's work in the world. This transformation is not limited to the disciples alone, but extends to all who respond to Jesus' call to follow him. It is a reminder that encountering Jesus has the power to completely reshape our lives and redirect our priorities. Moreover, this passage also highlights the urgency of the message that Jesus brings. Jesus declares,

"The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel." This proclamation emphasizes the need for immediate response and a change of heart. It is a call to turn away from the old ways of living and embrace the new life that Jesus offers.

This passage reveals the transformative power of encountering Jesus and the radical obedience and trust that his disciples displayed. It challenges us to examine our own response to Jesus' call and invites us to join in the work of the kingdom of God.


