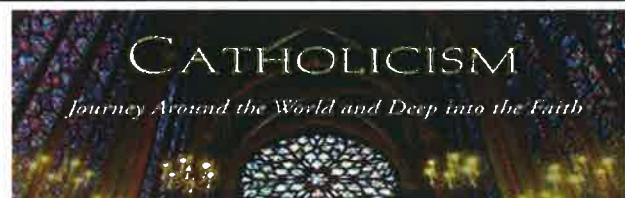

Food Pantry donation boxes remain in the back of St. Patricks Church and in the entrance to the parish office on Charles Street in Boonville for any donations.

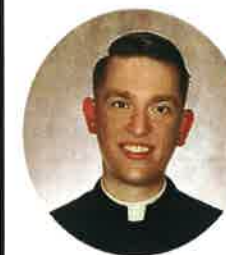
