This Wednesday we will celebrate Ash Wednesday. As you know this is a significant day in the Church calendar that marks the beginning of the season of Lent. It is a day of reflection, repentance, and renewal. The ashes that we put on our foreheads represent our mortality and the nature of life. They serve as a reminder that we are dust and to dust we shall return. This humbling realization prompts us to reflect on our own lives and the choices we have made. May this season of Lent be a time of transformation, as we embrace the invitation to turn our hearts back to God and experience His boundless love and mercy.
