

As we begin our Lenten journey, we hear the

temptation of Jesus in the desert in our Gospel reading. In Mark 1:12-15, we are presented with an account of Jesus' temptation in the wilderness and the beginning of his ministry. This passage holds significant meaning and offers valuable insights for our own spiritual journeys.

The wilderness represents a period of intense testing and isolation. Jesus spent forty days and nights without food, enduring physical and spiritual challenges. This reminds us that trials and temptations are an inevitable part of life. It is during these times of solitude and struggle that our faith is tested and refined.

Jesus' response to temptation teaches us the importance of relying on God's Word. 
