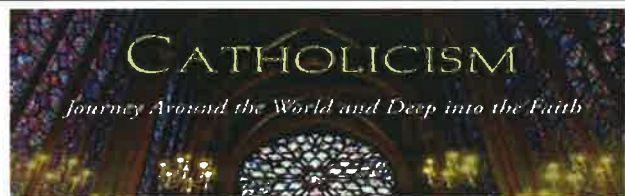

Dear Parishioners,



As we begin our Lenten journey, we hear the temptation of Jesus in the desert in our Gospel reading. In Mark 1:12-15, we are presented with an account of Jesus' temptation in the wilderness and the beginning of his ministry. This passage holds significant meaning and offers valuable insights for our own spiritual journeys. The wilderness represents a period of intense testing and isolation. Jesus spent forty days and nights without food, enduring physical and spiritual challenges. This reminds us that trials and temptations are an inevitable part of life. It is during these times of solitude and struggle that our faith is tested and refined.

Jesus' response to temptation teaches us the importance of relying on God's Word. When Satan tempted him, Jesus quoted Scripture, demonstrating that the Word of God is a powerful weapon against the enemy. This highlights the significance of regularly studying and meditating on Scripture to equip ourselves against the schemes of the devil. Furthermore, Jesus' proclamation of the Good News and the call to repentance remind us of the central message of Christianity. This emphasizes the urgency of recognizing our need for repentance and placing our trust in the redemptive work of Jesus.

Mark 1:12-15 offers a profound reflection on Jesus' temptation in the wilderness and the beginning of his ministry. It teaches us the importance of relying on God's Word, enduring trials with faith, and embracing the message of repentance and belief in the gospel. May we draw inspiration from this passage as we navigate our own spiritual journeys.



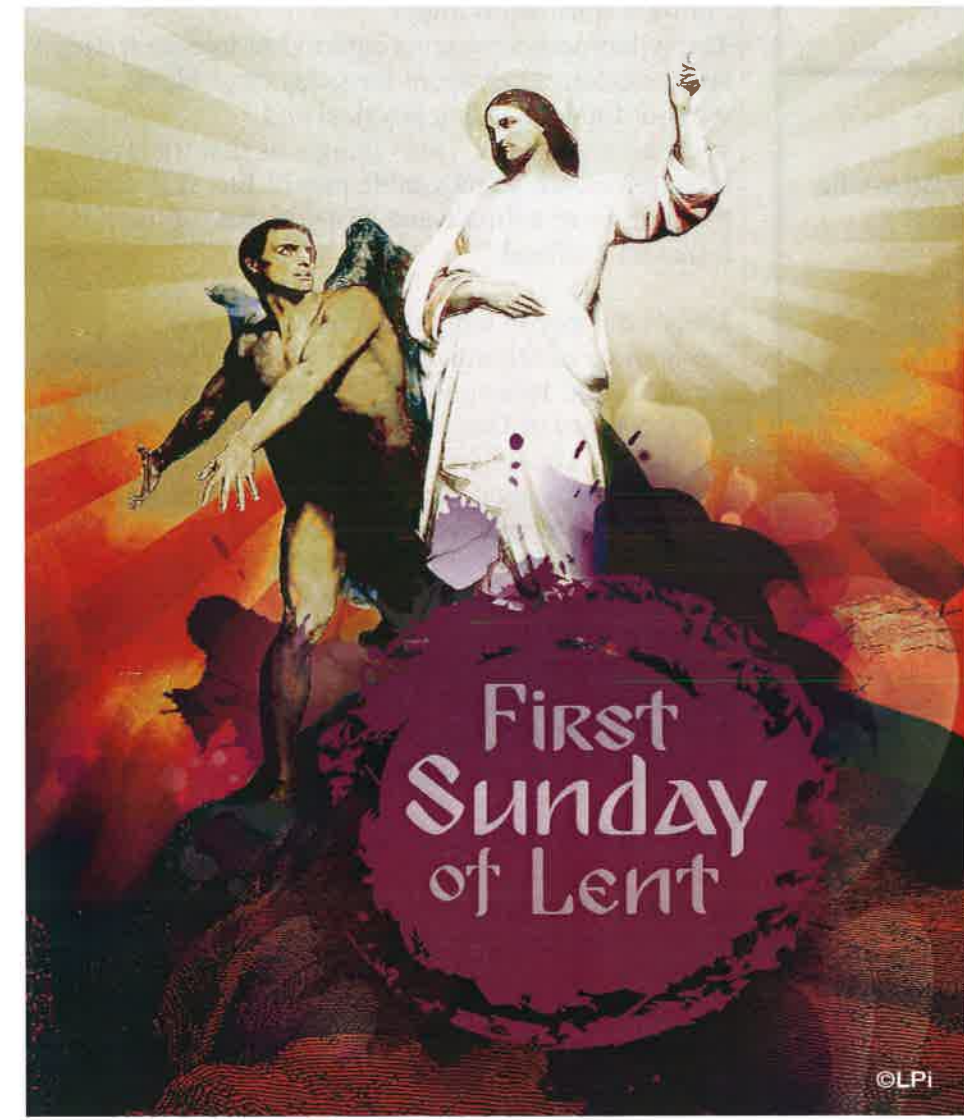
