Dear Parishioners,

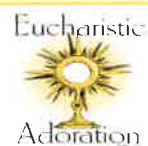


I want to take this opportunity to wish you and your family a Happy Easter! For each of us, we will celebrate today a little differently, but here at Church, we celebrate the same way by rejoicing in the Resurrection and singing Alleluia. For each of us, we have journeyed with Christ through His triumphant entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, His betrayal by Judas Iscariot, celebration of the Last Supper with His disciples, Passion, death, and Resurrection. Each of these days during this past week have been met with a different theme, and we recall them each year that we celebrate Holy Week.

Last Evening, we processed into the Church with the Easter Candle to a completely darkened Church. This symbolizes many things but at the heart of it is Christ's victory over Death.
