Dear friends in Christ,

This weekend we celebrate he Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. The Church refers to the Eucharistic sacrifice as the source and summit of our Catholic faith. Saint Pope John Paul II helps us to understand the importance of the mass which is the new Passover or Paschal Mystery:

The Church was born of the paschal mystery. For this very reason the Eucharist, which is in an outstanding way the sacrament of the paschal mystery, stands at the center of the Church's life. This is already clear from the earliest images of the Church found in the Acts of the Apostles: "They devoted themselves to the Apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers" (2:42). The "breaking of the bread" refers to the

Eucharist. Two thousand years later, we continue to relive that primordial image of the Church. At every celebration of the Eucharist, we are spiritually brought back to the paschal Triduum: to the events of the evening of Holy Thursday, to the Last Supper and to what followed it...The thought of this leads us to profound amazement and gratitude. In the paschal event and the Eucharist which makes it present throughout the centuries, there is a truly enormous "capacity" which embraces all of history as the recipient of the grace of the redemption. This amazement should always fill the Church assembled for the celebration of the Eucharist. (ECCLESIA DE EUCHARISTIA, #3)

It is important to grow in our reverence for the gift we have in Jesus present in the Eucharist. Each of us can grow in our amazement at so great a gift especially if we make our own the prayer for increased faith: Lord, I believe, help me in my unbelief. (Mark 9:24)

Finally, it is important to invite others to encounter this great gift of God's love. For anyone above the age of reason (normally, seven years of age) and particularly adults, the way to become a Catholic is through a process called The Rite of Christian of Adults (RCIA). The RCIA is for both unbaptized persons and for baptized Christians who wish now to live their baptismal life in the tradition of the Catholic Church. We have already scheduled our first RCIA inquiry for Tuesday, June 25 from 6pm to 7pm at Gill Hall in Boonville, All we need is candidates. Let us not keep the gift of Jesus just for ourselves but recognize others in our midst who are in need of His love, hope and healing. Please pray for such people and humbly invite them to join us. 
